2022 Advocacy Successes



PMA has achieved many federal lobbying successes in 2022 through its One Voice advocacy team in Washington, D.C. This is a partial list of accomplishments:



Supply Chains and Trade

- Worked to make forming and machining included as priority in supply-chain-resiliency law
- Testified on steel, aluminum tariffs at U.S. International Trade Commission
- Succeeded in passing semiconductor-investment law
- Working with Commerce Department on CHIPS implementation



Workforce

- Helped secure \$11 billion for workforce and R&D funding
- Lobbying to increase federal funding for career technical education
- Working to expand Pell Grants
- Succeeded in having manufacturing institutes now emphasize workforce, education



Taxes

- Defeated tax increases on passthrough businesses
- Expanded new Advanced Manufacturing Production Credit to renewable-energy components
- Assisted Last-in-First-out coalition in supporting LIFO
- Prevented lowering the estate-tax threshold



Regulations

- Met with OSHA on indoor 80-degree heat index rule
- Working with coalition on temporary-worker regulation
- Lobbying to defeat PRO Act union bill in the Senate
